## WHAT TO BRING!



Hope you are as excited as we are about Kamp this year! To make sure that everyone is prepared to have a good time, please use the following checklist when packing.

Make sure that every piece of clothing & gear (especially flashlight) has your name on it!

1. Sleeping bag or sheets/blanket
2. Pillow
3. Laundry bag
4. Short & long sleeved shirts
5. Short & long pants
6. Daily supply of underwear and socks
7. 2 pairs of sneakers (no open toes) – Crocs are ok.
8. PJs
9. Raingear Very Important!!
10. Flashlight (with good batteries)
11. Bible
12. Swimsuit (one piece only, please)
13. Light jacket or heavy shirt (It can get chilly during evening activities)
14. Two towels (one for the pool, the other for the cabin/bathhouse)
15. Toiletries (soap, toothbrush/paste, comb, etc)
16. Insect repellent
17. Sunscreen (SPF 20 min)
18. The theme for the dance is: **LUAU**

### Optional

Camera, stationary & stamps, hiking boots, sandals, playing cards; tennis racket

### DO NOT BRING

Any electric or electronic device. This includes radios, cd players, computers, handheld video games, PDAs, cell phones, etc. (If it plugs in or takes batteries, leave it at home.)

Candy, pop, food, gum, etc.

Makeup

Fireworks, sparklers, etc.

Tobacco, unauthorized drugs, alcohol.

This is a Christian camp. Modest dress is requested. No undergarments may be exposed. No tobacco or alcohol or other inappropriate messages or logos may be worn. No spaghetti straps please. Dress to be active and have fun at camp!

## THINGS TO KNOW

OPENING DAY CHECK-IN: Between 2:00 p.m. and 4:00 p.m., Saturday, July 31, 2010. Check-in will take place at the chapel. Upon entering Camp Michawana, turn right and proceed to the parking lot. There will be many people along the road to guide you. **Check-in will not begin before 2:00 p.m.**, and the main gate will be closed until that time. You will need to bring the gold Health Form, one per camper.

MEDICATIONS: All medications, including aspirin, must be clearly marked with the camper's name and administration procedures, and must be given to the Health Officer at check-in. The health officer will dispense the medication accordingly. The medication will be returned to you at check-out. **THERE IS NO MEDICATION ALLOWED IN CABINS.**

CLOSING DAY CHECK-OUT: Check-out is 4:00 on Friday, August 6, 2010 at Redeemer. Kampers will be bussed back to the church, unless you specify that you will pick you camper up at Camp Michawana before Noon on Aug. 6. Please do not grab your child and leave. Please stop at the table that is set up on the side walk and let us know. We do this in case there is some pertinent information we need to give you and in order to return your medications.

KAMP REUNION CONCERT: Our Kamp Reunion Concert starring Peter Neumann will be held Wednesday, August 11 from 6:30 to 8:30 at Redeemer. Everyone is welcome. Bring the whole family!

MONEY AND VALUABLES: We are unable to assume responsibility for the loss of jewelry and valuables brought to camp. Please leave them at home. No money should be brought to camp. There is nothing to buy.

**TELEPHONE:** Campers may not use the camp telephone. In an emergency, contact Mark Wuggazer at (248) 767-4649.

**LOST AND FOUND:** Invariably, the Camp Director brings stuff home, and throws it out 2 weeks later because no one claimed it. Please mark all belongings with your name, and this will make it easy for the poor guy to return it to you. Unclaimed items are thrown out or donated to charity two weeks after camp.

**NO SNACKS/BEVERAGES:** Snacks and beverages are plentifully provided. Please do not bring anything, or mail anything to camp. If the mice don't get it, the counselors will.

**THERE IS NO CAMPER LAUNDRY:** Please send/bring enough clothing for the entire week.

**DRESS CODE:** This is a Christian camp. Modest dress is requested. Please bring a one piece bathing suit only. No undergarments may be exposed. No tobacco or alcohol or other inappropriate messages or logos may be worn. No spaghetti straps please. No two-piece bathing suits. Dress to be active and have fun at camp!

**SPECIAL INSTRUCTIONS:** If you have special instructions or information you wish to give about your child to the Camp Director or the Health officer, please do so when your child and other campers are not present. The Camp Director and Health officer will be glad to speak to you at check-in, or call Mark Wuggazer at 248-644-4010 x27.

**HEALTH HISTORY FORM:** This form must be completed entirely and signed by the camper's parent or legal guardian. This is State law, and we cannot accept a camper at check-in without this form appropriately completed.

**SMOKING / ALCOHOL / DRUG USE:** All are prohibited at camp. Disobedience of this rule will result in the camper being dismissed from camp immediately.

**FEES:** Your camp fee is to be paid in full at registration. A Pro-rated refund will be made in the event of withdrawal for the reason of illness or injury only. **NO REFUND** will be made if the child does not attend camp because of voluntary cancellation, withdrawal or is dismissed from the camp at any time during the camp period. Redeemer Summer Kamp reserves the right to dismiss any camper whose behavior is detrimental to the safety and well-being of the other campers at the discretion of the Camp Director.
